

DTV Cargo Insurance Conditions 2000
(DTV-Cargo 2000) Strikes, Riots and Civil Commotions Clause
for insurances governed by DTV-Cargo 2000
November 2000 Version

1. Scope of cover

- 1.1 Notwithstanding No. 2.4.1.2 DTV-Cargo 2000, the insurance shall extend to loss of or damage to insured goods caused by strikers, locked out workmen, or persons involved in labour disturbances, terrorist or political acts of violence - regardless of the number - or involved in riots or civil commotions.
- 1.2 Furthermore, cover shall extend to loss of or damage to insured goods caused by the intervention of authorities with governmental powers (police force or fire brigade) in connection with the above insured events.

2. Cancellation

- 2.1 The insurance against the risks as per Sect. 1 may be cancelled by the insurer at any time provided notice be given two days prior to attachment of the insurance. The insurance of goods in storage - excluding intermediate storage in the ordinary course of transit - may also be cancelled subsequent to attachment of the risk, such cancellation to become effective on the next declared expiry date - but not later than one month - following expiry of the period of notice.
- 2.2 The notice of cancellation given by the leading Underwriter shall also apply for the co-insurers.
